

SAFFTY INSTRUCTIONS

- · Read ALL the instructions before using this product.
- · Check that the heater and all supplied accessories are present and intact.
- Always check your mains supply is the same as that indicated on the product before connecting.
- Always disconnect the heater from the electrical supply before carrying out cleaning or maintenance. To disconnect the heater, switch controls to OFF then remove plug from the outlet.
- · Always unplug the heater if it is going to be out of use for long periods of time.
- Do not use the heater near flammable or explosive materials.
- Do not use the heater if the casing, wire or plug are damaged.
- Avoid the use of an extension cord which may overheat and cause risk of fire. If an extension
 cord is necessary, it must be rated above the maximum rated power of the appliance. Care
 must be taken to arrange the cord so that it cannot be pulled or be tripped over.
- This appliance can be used by children aged from 8 years and above and persons with reduced physical, sensory or mental capabilities or lack of experience and knowledge if they have been given supervision or instruction concerning use of the appliance in a safe way and understand the hazards involved.
- If the supply cord is damaged, it must be replaced by the manufacturer, its service agent or similarly qualified persons in order to avoid a hazard.


- The heater must not be located immediately below a socket outlet.
- Children of less than 3 years should be kept away unless continuously supervised.
- · Cleaning and user maintenance shall not be carried out by children without supervision.
- CAUTION: In order to avoid a hazard due to inadvertent resetting of the thermal cutout, this appliance must not be supplied through an external switching device, such as a timer, or connected to a circuit that is regularly switched on and off by the utility.
- Fixed heaters are to be installed so that switches and other controls cannot be touched by a
 person in the bath or shower.
- Children aged from 3 and less that 8 shall only switch on/off the appliance provided that it
 has been placed or installed in its intended normal operating position and they have been
 given supervision or instruction concerning use of the appliance in a safe way and
 understand the hazards involved. Children aged from 3 years and less than 8 years
 shall not plug in, reaulate and clean the appliance or perform user maintenance.
- CAUTION: Some parts of this product can become very hot and cause burns.


 Particular attention has to be given where children and vulnerable people are present.
- This heater is not when in use. To avoid burns, do not touch hot surfaces such as surfaces around the grille in front of the heater. Never let bare skin touch hot surfaces.
- Do not use this heater in the immediate surroundings of a bath, a shower or a swimming pool.
- Do not use this heater if it has been dropped or if there are visible signs of damage.

Minimum Distances


Please ensure the minimum distances from the floor, ceiling and walls are observed and adhered to.





IMPORTANT: Before use, ensure the radiator is securely mounted to the wall.

OPERATION

Press the Standby key 0 to turn the heater on or off.

Setting the Day and Time

Follow the steps below to set the day and time. The day and time must be set for the Timer Programs to work correctly.

 Long press M to enter the time setting screen. The number 1 will flash (1 to 7 represent Monday to Friday).

- Press A w to select the current day. For example, if it is Wednesday you need
 to select 3. Press I to confirm and enter hour setting.
- Press & to select the current hour. Press to confirm and enter minute setting.
- Press A & to select the current minute. Press to confirm. After the minute is set, the display will return to the main screen.

During setting, you can press **M** to return to the previous step.

The device will automatically confirm the setting if there is no action for 10 seconds.

You can change the day and time at anytime by long press M.

The time and set temperature will display on the screen alternately.

Selecting Different Modes

- Short press M to switch between different modes. You can select Comfort ♠, Comfort - 1°C ♠, Comfort -2°C ऴ, ECO), Anti-Frost ♠, Open Window Detection III, Preset Program 1 P1, Preset Program 2 P2, Preset Program 3 P3, Program P and FP modes.
- The corresponding mode will appear on the screen. Press

 to confirm selection.
 It will automatically confirm the mode if there is no action for 10 seconds.

Temperature Setting

- Short press M to choose Comfort * mode.
- Press A to select your temperature for Comfort mode. The temperature will
 adjust by 0.5°C with each press. The temperature ranges from 5°C to 30°C.
- Press

 to confirm.

The device will automatically confirm the setting if there is no action for 10 seconds.

ECO ightharpoonup mode temperature will automatically adjust by -3.5°C according to the Comfort ightharpoonup mode temperature.

Comfort -1°C \clubsuit mode temperature will automatically adjust by -1°C according to the Comfort \clubsuit mode temperature.

Comfort -2°C \$\times\$ mode temperature will automatically adjust by -2°C according to the Comfort \$\times\$ mode temperature.

Open Window Detection

When you select Open Window Detection $\overline{\mathbf{II}}$, the device will enter Comfort $\stackrel{\bigstar}{\Rightarrow}$ mode as default and detect if any windows are open or not.

If the device detects an open window, the device will automatically enter Anti-Frost $\ensuremath{\mbox{\$}}$ mode.

- Short press **M** and select Open Window Detection. The **III** icon will display on screen.
- Press

 to confirm.
- Press **M** to select other modes, or press Standby 0 to cancel Open Window Detection.

Pre-set Programs P1 / P2 / P3

- Short press M to choose different pre-set programs. The device works from Monday to Sunday, 00:00 - 23:59 according to the default setting as shown below.
- Press

 to confirm.

Program Setting P

You can set the working mode according to your life habit for 7 days / 24 hours.

Press M to select P, press

to confirm.

Modify Program Setting P / P1 / P2 / P3

You can modify the programs when your device is working under the corresponding program. For example, you can modify **P1** whilst the device is working under **P1** mode.

- Press M to select the working mode you want to modify, then press
 to confirm selection.
- Long press M and at the same time to enter modification mode. At that time, number 1 is flashing.
- Press A & to select the day you want to set. Press d to confirm and enter hour selection.
- Press ▲ & ➤ to select the time you want to set. Press → to confirm and enter mode selection.
- Press A & to select the mode for this hour. The selected mode icon will flash on the screen. Press to confirm mode.

During setting, you can press **M** to return to the previous step.

During setting, you can long press **M** and **I** at the same time again to quit the program setting. All the confirmed settings will be remembered.

For other day settings, repeat the above operation.

The device will automatically confirm the setting if there is no action for 30 seconds.

NOTE: During program modification, only Comfort, Comfort -1°C, Comfort -2°C, ECO and Anti-Frost can be selected.

Child Lock

- Long press
 → for 3 seconds to activate Child Lock. The → icon will display on the screen. The buttons will lock.
- To unlock, press
 again for 3 seconds.

NOTE: The Child Lock will not lock the Standby (1) button.

The lock function will automatically deactive under the below circumstances:

- 1. The device is turned off by pressing the Standby (b) button.
- The device suffers a power disconnection. You will need to long press

 for 3 seconds to reactivate the Child Lock function.

Fil-Pilot Wire Mode FP

This product works under the control of a pilot wire control box. The **FP** icon and correspoding working mode icon will display on screen.

Press M to select FP mode.

Press 🔟 to confirm selection.

WIFI Connection

 This product comes with a WiFi ? function. You can download the Smart Life app with the below QR code and register an account.



- Once the registration is complete, you can connect to the WiFi by pressing \$\times\$ & \$\times\$ at the same time until you hear a beep sound twice. The WiFi \$\frac{1}{2}\$ icon will display on the device's screen.
- In the Smart Life app, press + in the top right to add device.
- Follow the instructions shown on the app to connect your device.
- You can now use the Smart Life app on your phone to control the device.

TROUBLESHOOTING

PROBLEM	SOLUTION
The appliance does not heat	Ensure that the circuit breakers are switched on the installation, or the shredder did not cut the power supply (if the installation has one.
	2. Select the Comfort mode.
	3. Increase the temperature setting.
The device heats permanently	1. Ensue the device is not in a draft.
	2. Reduce the temperature setting.

IN CASE OF POWER FAILURE

- If the power supply is cut, after recovery, the device will beep once and reutnr to the working mode and time before the power failure. The ① icon will flash on screen to remind you to reset the day and time.
- If the time is correct, press
 to confirm, and (1) icon will disappear.
- If the time is not correct, long press M to reset the day and time. Once the day and time reset, the (2) icon will disappear. The device will return to the corresponding work made

CARE & CLEANING

- Before cleaning the appliance, switch off the power supply and wait until it is completely cooled.
- 2. Use a damp cloth to clean the housing of the device.
- Clean grilles and air outlet regularly. Never immerse the appliance in water or allow water to enter the appliance.
